The Colorado Senior Pro Charity Rodeo Association (CSPCR) is proud to present its 25th Annual National Senior Pro Rodeo August 20th & 21st, 2010 in the beautiful mountain town of Estes Park, Colorado.

The CSPCR has been presenting Senior Pro Rodeos since 1986. Profits from rodeo proceeds are donated to local Colorado charities. These charities include the Susan G. Komen Foundation, Our Center, Craig Hospital and our main charity, Meals On Wheels. More than \$100,000 has been donated by this rodeo organization.

The National Senior Pro Rodeo Association sanctions rodeos throughout the United States and Canada. As the name Senior Pro indicates, these rodeos are for contestants that are at least 40 years of age. The events are split into age categories: 40-50, 50-60 and 60-plus. Some special events have additional age divisions.

Throw Ol' Paint an extra flake of hay, put on your best glad rag, and make your way to The Fairgrounds at Stanley Park for the 2010 Colorado Senior Pro Charity Rodeo August 20th & 21st. Performances will start Friday and Saturday night at 7 p.m. with the pre-rodeo drill team, the Clover Leaf Riders. This 4-H equestrian group has been entertaining rodeo crowds for more than 20 years. Some of the original members are now parents with their own children participating in this same talented group.
